AUR Release 7

Accessory Fitting new qualification;

- **create** three new units of competency; and
- **update** three existing units of competency.

Battery Electric Vehicle Repair

- **create** one new qualification; and
- **create** two new units of competency.

Heavy Vehicle Telematics Service and Repair

- **update** one existing unit of competency.



AUR Release 7

- The AUR Release 7 Case for Endorsement was approved by the AISC on the 12th October 2021.
- At this stage AURr7 has not appeared on TGA.



Vet Reform

Aim

- Remove under-utilized qualifications and units
- Broaden vocational outcomes – produce transferable skills.
 - Reduce complexity of qualification and unit structure

Vet Reform

Implementation

- The new system, based around Industry Clusters, will be in place by 1st of January 2023.
 - Proposed, nine Industry Clusters.
- Industry will develop a proposal, in order to win a government grant, for an Industry Cluster (throughout 2022).
 - Existing SSOs and IRCs will remain in place during the transition period, 2022.



Future

 - What will the new system look like?
- What will be the conduit between industry/RTOs and Industry Clusters?
 - Will PwC be part of the new mix?
